Conditions of Entry

Eligibility

To be eligible to participate the players entered must be fully qualified members of the PGA who nominate their entry, and must actively be working for a minimum of **25 hours** in a normal week within the golfing industry on a continuous basis. For clarification, working within the golfing industry is defined as working within the professional shop environment, teaching, administration, such as a Golf Director or activity of a similar nature.

Please note: This definition does not include full time playing professionals or non-qualified trainees/assistants.

For Countries with an Approved Training Programme:

A fully qualified member as recognised by The PGAs of Europe is a Professional who has taken, fully completed and passed a training or education programme approved by The PGAs of Europe.

For Countries WITHOUT an Approved Training Programme:

Where the National PGA that nominates the entry is not yet operating a fully approved Training Programme as per The PGAs of Europe regulations, a fully qualified member is a Professional who is recognised as a full member (not a full time playing professional or trainee/assistant) by that PGA.

In addition the following applies:

 Any professional who has competed in more than 4 European Tour events in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 seasons by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.









- Any professional who has competed in more than 4 European Challenge Tour or Web.com Tour events in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 seasons by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.
- Any professional who has competed in more than 4 events on any Tour that is a member (full or affiliate) of the International Federation of PGA Tours in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 season by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.
- Any professional who has competed in more than 6 European Seniors Tour or Champions Tour events in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 seasons by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.
- Any Professional who has competed in more than 6 Satellite Development Tour events (these Tours are the PGA Europro Tour, The Pro Golf Tour, The Alps Tour and The Nordic League) in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 seasons by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.
- Any professional who has competed in more than 4 events on the Ladies European Tour, LPGA Tour or LPGA of Japan Tour in any one season during either the 2013 or 2014 season by the closing date for entries will not be eligible for a period of two years.
- The senior PGA official or Executive of each country will be responsible for clarification that each Professional nominated for entry satisfies all of the above criteria.

Should further clarification of eligibility be necessary, the decision of The PGAs of Europe Board will be final.

Conditions

1. Conditions of Play

The Championship is a 72-hole Team Strokeplay event. The Championship will be played over 18 holes on the New Course, Gloria Golf Resort, by each member of each Team on each of the 4 tournament days. Each Team comprises of three members. There is no cut.









On each day the best two individual scores from the Team of three will count towards the overall Team score. The Team with the lowest eight-score total will be the Winners.

In the event of a tie a sudden death play-off will be staged to determine the winning team. The Team Captain will nominate one person to represent the Team in the play-off.

Due to the BEKO Classic Pro-Am being played over both the New and Old courses at Gloria Golf Resort on 4th-6th December please note that Practice Rounds are restricted to Sunday 7th December only. No booking is necessary.









4. Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided for each team member on an Ultra All-Inclusive basis at the Gloria Golf Hotel for the nights of $6^{th} - 11^{th}$ December inclusive (6 nights). Extra nights are to be paid for directly to the hotel.

5. Transportation

A shuttle service will run from the hotel starting at 0645 hours each day to take competitors to the New Course. Return shuttles will begin from 1300 from the clubhouse back to the hotel.

The timings for the shuttle will be on the Championship noticeboard and the hotel noticeboard.

6. Welcome Reception

There will be a Welcome Reception for both players and Annual Congress delegates at the Gloria Golf Hotel on the evening of the 7th December. All competitors are required to attend as a condition of entry. The Dress Code for the evening is smart casual.

7. Prize Presentation, Gala Dinner & Annual Awards

The Prize Presentation will take place at the Gala Dinner and Annual Awards on Thursday 11th December at the Gloria Golf Hotel.

All competitors are required to attend as a condition of entry. The Dress code for the evening is Jacket, Collar and tie.
